Re: Important Notice Concerning Coronavirus Vaccinations for Foreign Caregivers

Following numerous inquiries regarding vaccinations for foreign caregivers, and after our office contacted the Ministry of Health urgently concerning this matter, we have been informed by Health Ministry officials that foreign caregivers who are insured by their employer with private health insurance can be vaccinated at the Kupot Holim (HMOs) together with their elderly or handicapped employers, regardless of whether the foreign workers belong (or don't belong) to the same Kupat Holim (HMO).

Thus, a foreign worker employed by an elderly or handicapped employer can go to the Kupat Holim (HMO) that the employer belongs to, and be vaccinated together with the employer against the coronavirus.

We were also informed that the Ministry of Health intends to vaccinate all foreign workers residing in Israel, irrespective of the medical insurance that they possess, in order to reduce the incidence of the coronavirus in the country.

We are continuing to monitor the situation closely, and will issue updates in this regard.

We recommend that you follow the instructions of the Ministry of Health, which publishes information that is known about the vaccination, including medical indications for administering of the vaccination, how it is given, possible side effects, and how to report them.
